ABOUT

Fredericksburg, VA tells America's story - from 1608 when Captain John Smith sailed up the Rappahannock River to George Washington's childhood and adolescence to John DeBaptiste, a free Black man fighting in the Revolutionary War to the Civil War with four major battles and where 10,000 enslaved people crossed the river to freedom, to Reconstruction and the fight for Civil Rights and social justice. The region is filled with historic sites and compelling stories, a phenomenal food and drink scene and is all easily accessible just off the interstate.

LOCATION

Fredericksburg, VA is located fifty miles south of Washington, D.C. on Interstate 95, midway between Washington, D.C. and Richmond, Virginia.

Tours & Activities

TROLLEY TOURS OF FREDERICKSBURG

This 75-minute tour includes historic homes, attractions, and the famous Sunken Road, site of the Battle of Fredericksburg.

GUIDE SERVICE

Guide service is available for an overview tour of the city, battlefield tour, or African American history tour. Please contact our office for these arrangements.

CIVIL WAR TOURS

Visit the sites of four major Civil War battles including the Fredericksburg/ Spotsylvania National Military Park with over 8,000 acres of preserved land. Step on guides are available to enhance your tour.

COLONIAL HISTORY TOURS

Visit the George Washington family homes including the Mary Washington House, Kenmore, the Rising Sun Tavern and his boyhood home at Ferry Farm. Explore colonial medicine at the Hugh Mercer Apothecary Shop and learn about our fifth President at the James Monroe Museum and Memorial Library.

TRAIL TO FREEDOM

Based on the story of John Washington, an enslaved Black man who grew up in Fredericksburg before escaping across the Rappahannock River to the Union Army. Later, John Washington would write about his experience of being enslaved in Fredericksburg.

RIVERSIDE CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS

Winner of the 2019 Theater of the Year for Central Virginia Award by Broadway World, The Riverside Center for the Performing Arts features professional "Broadway musicals" each season. A three course dinner is served at your table.

A. SMITH BOWMAN DISTILLERY

Experience a behind-the-scenes glimpse into the production of hand-crafted, award-winning spirits. The hour-long guided tours are by appointment and explore distillation, barreling and bottling of bourbon. A. Smith Bowman products will be available for tasting and purchase. VIRGINIA CREDIT UNION BASEBALL STADIUM

Home of the Fredericksburg Nationals, and farm team to the Washington Nationals. Games will be held seasonally and includes an exhibit on the history of baseball in Fredericksburg.

SHANNON AIR MUSEUM

See multiple examples of early aircraft, including the only known surviving Vultee V-1A, the SPAD VII prized fighter from World War I, the Pitcairn PA-5 Mailwing and the Bellanca CH-400 Skyrocket.

FUNLAND OF FREDERICKSBURG

Virginia's only three story Go-Kart Track, 100 arcade games, laser tag and much more!

NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE MARINE CORPS

This museum details the Marine's contributions to the American people.

THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY

Celebrates Army History, as well as the Army Reserves and the Army National Guard. (45mins from Fredericksburg)



FREDERICKSBURG CONVENTION CENTER

This multi-purpose facility is capable of hosting trade shows, consumer shows, receptions, banquets, meetings and conventions for up to 3,400 attendees. They boast an 80,000 sq. ft. exhibition hall, 10,000 sq. ft. ballroom and 11 meeting rooms. Hampton Inn and Suites, Homewood Suites and Hilton Garden Inn are adjacent to the Convention Center, all with additional meeting space. A fourth hotel, Silver Collection Hotel, opened in August 2020 with 24 suites. This brand new hotel offers a completely touchless experience.

VIRGINIA CREDIT UNION BASEBALL STADIUM

The home of the Fredericksburg Nationals has multiple opportunities for groups and meetings. Able to accommodate groups of 25 to 5,000, this stadium can host attendees in the Bullpen Party Deck, Scoreboard Suite, 1st or 3rd Base Party Decks. Perhaps your group would like to keep score for the FredNats in the Scoreboard Suites. On-site food and beverage will be available. Located adjacent to the Fredericksburg Convention Center and hotel complex.

CLARION HOTEL & SUITES CONVENTION CENTER FREDERICKSBURG

190 sleeping rooms, with over 18,000 sq. ft. of meeting space, 2 restaurants on site, located in Central Park with multiple restaurant, shopping and entertainment options.
