DAY 1

2:00 p.m. Wine and Design Painting Class

4:00 p.m. Return to the hotel

6:30 a.m. -8:00 a.m. Breakfast at hotel

11:00 a.m. Gari Melchers' Home and Studio at Belmont

12:30 p.m. <u>Lunch at Billiken's Smokehouse</u>

Fredericksburg, VA tells America's story – from 1608 when Captain John Smith sailed up the Rappahannock River to George Washington's childhood and adolescence to John DeBaptiste, a free Black man fighting in the Revolutionary War to the Civil War with four major battles and where 10,000 enslaved people crossed the river to freedom, to Reconstruction and the fight for Civil Rights and social justice. The region is filled with historic sites and compelling stories, a phenomenal food and drink scene and is all easily accessible just off the interstate.
