

FREDERICKSBURG, VA

tells America's story - from 1608 when Captain John Smith sailed up the Rappahannock River to George Washington's childhood and adolescence to John DeBaptiste, a free Black man fighting in the Revolutionary War to the Civil War with four major battles and where 10,000 enslaved people crossed the river to freedom, to Reconstruction and the fight for Civil Rights and social justice. The region is filled with historic sites and compelling stories, a phenomenal food and drink scene and is all easily accessible just off the interstate.





Featured Sites

VIRGINIA CREDIT UNION BASEBALL STADIUM

The Virginia Credit Union Stadium, home of the Fredericksburg
Nationals, opened for the Minor League Baseball season in 2021. The
new 5,000 seat, 300,000 square foot Stadium has multiple uses for nongame day events and sports. With a turf field made out of shaved
coconut husks and sand that keeps the field cooler than other traditional
surfaces, a large variety of sports and events are possible throughout the
year. The Stadium also features LED lights through the facility and solarpowered lighting in the parking lot. On-site concessions, lockers rooms,
batting cages, and as well as several different event spaces around the
Stadium are options for different events. Indoor space includes the Club
Room - 6,000 square feet; Luxury Suites - 375 square feet, Clubhouse 1,600 to 970 square feet.

FREDERICKSBURG EXPO AND CONVENTION CENTER

The Fredericksburg Expo & Conference Center is a 110,000 square foot facility capable of hosting a variety of sports events including fencing, gymnastics, drone competitions, volleyball, basketball, wrestling and much more for 3,400 attendees. Exhibit Hall A & B combined are 80,000 square feet with 60-foot-wide distances between columns. All utilities are accessible via drops from the ceiling. The ceiling is 30' high at the center and slopes down to 26' on the sides. Loading dock doors and ramps allowed full size tractor trailers to enter the facility for setup. The facility is non-union. The Fredericksburg Expo & Conference Center offers a total of eleven meeting rooms. The Ballroom divides into six separate sections and comfortably accommodates up to 700 guests. Chairs, tables, carpet, drapes and AV are available from the Fredericksburg Expo and Conference Center. Over 1,000 parking

space are available.
